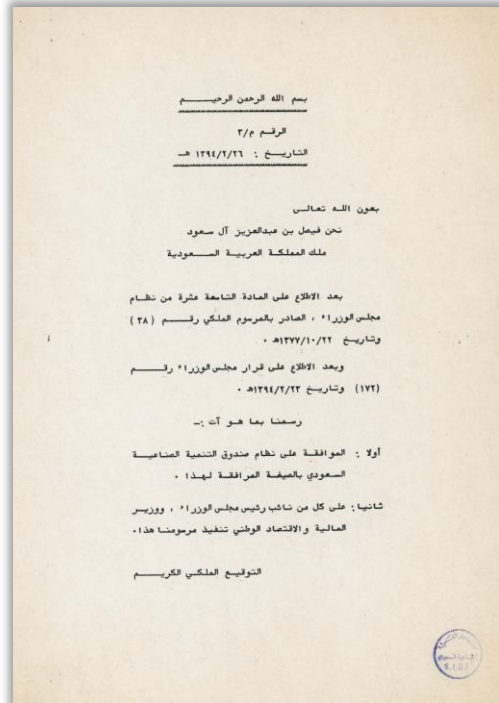

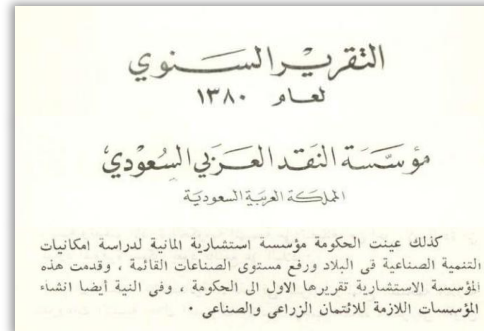

SIDF Establishment



In 1974, Royal Decree M/3 of year 1394 AH was issued, approving the foundation of Saudi Industrial Development Fund. An operating and training agreement was concluded with Chase Manhattan Bank, and the first loans were approved in the sectors of batteries, chemicals, air conditioners, and construction materials.



In 1960 AD, the intention to establish the 'Industrial Bank' was announced in the first annual report of the Saudi Arabian Monetary Agency (currently the Saudi Central Bank).



In the mid-1960s, His Majesty King Faisal, may he rest in peace, met with banking leaders in New York City. Chase Manhattan Bank proposed to the Saudi government the establishment of an industrial investment bank.

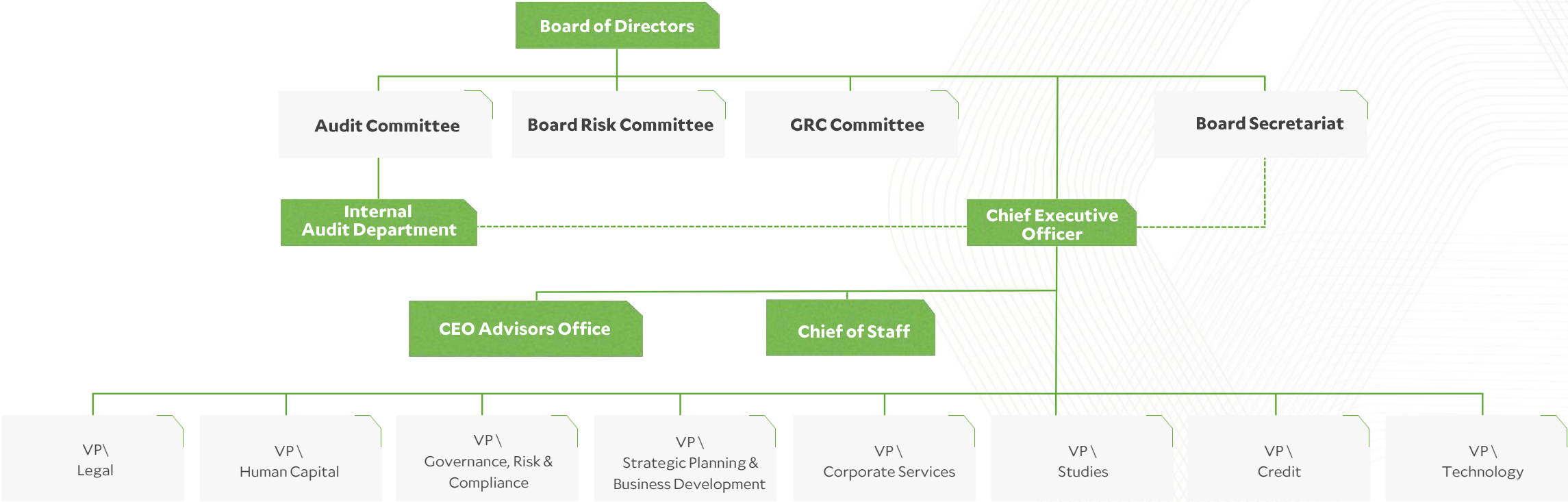

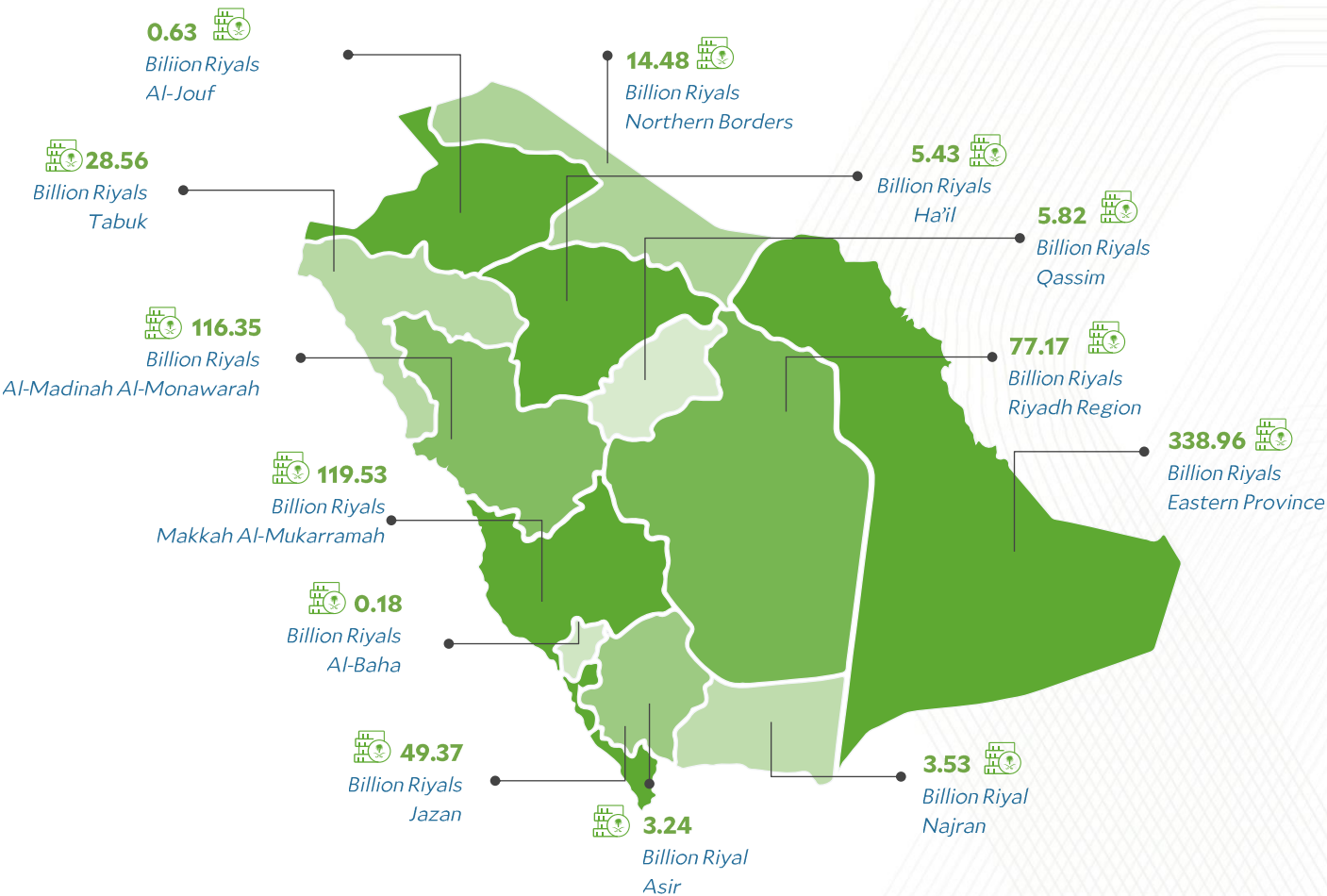

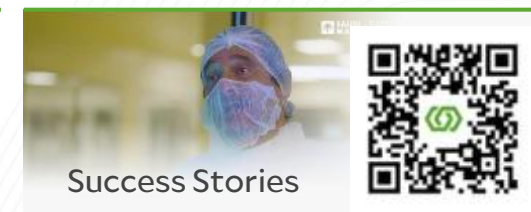
